**Acknowledgement of Commitment to Program - 2023** 

The vision for this program is to provide more GNA umpires with the opportunity to experience umpiring in the Representative Arena, obtain extensive coaching and represent GNA at an elite level.

This program has been designed to ensure all umpires are provided every opportunity to progress through their umpiring journey, enhancing their skills, and reach their umpiring dreams and goals.

## Requirements

All applicants that apply to be in the Representative Umpire Program must hold a current pass in the Netball Australia Rules of Netball Theory Exam, be registered with GNA, hold a minimum of an Association White Award, and hold, or be prepared to complete the Foundation Umpire Education Course in the year of representation.

## Commitment

Umpires who are accepted into the 2023 Program will be expected to attend program and training sessions, Representative carnivals, and umpire allocated Representative games during the winter competition.

Each umpire in the Representative Program will be expected to attend a minimum of 3 carnivals per year and 2 selection dates.

Upon Selection into the Umpire Program and at the first official training session, umpires will be awarded with a GNA Representative Umpire shirt. This shirt must be worn in conjunction with a white skirt or shorts, at each GNA carnival attended and each allocated Saturday GNA game.

Umpires in the program will not receive payment for umpiring allocated Saturday GNA games, attending carnival or selections.

Umpires selected to attend Junior State Titles, Senior State Title and Masters State Titles will be paid.
